

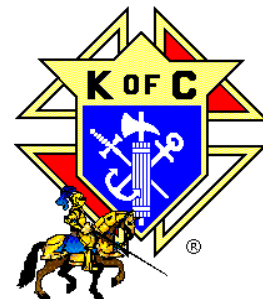

#### FROM THE GRAND KNIGHT:

Brother Knights,

This time of year has always been a time for looking back on the past year, and more importantly, forward to the coming year. It's a time to reflect on the changes we want (or need) to make and to resolve to follow through on those changes.

It is also a time when I find myself asking the ever familiar questions "Am I doing what God wants me to do? What does God expect of me? Have I missed what God has told me to do?" I have not had God

speak to me and I have not seen a great epiphany. Even so, I must still have faith that God will lead me where I need to be.

So...we start with the basics; we know that God wants us to love others, to read the Bible, to pray, to witness, to evangelize others, etc. We also know that as much as God wants to be close to us, he does not expect perfection. God is aware of the gap between his perfection and our sinfulness. Even with this knowledge, there is still a constant tension within us to try to close that gap, so that we feel more comfortable, so that we feel closer to God. Others will try to close the gap by trying to raise their performance: "I'll try harder..." Where do you fall? God has provided his commandments as rules to live by. He has given us the Bible to read and to learn. We have Him and our fellow Christians to teach us... to rely on. It is human nature, however, to think that now that you know the Bible a little, now that you know a little bit about prayer, or now that you may understand a little

about talking to others about God...we must be doing more. Although we should never stop striving to improve our relationship with God, maybe, just maybe we are doing exactly what God needs us to do! CHARITY, UNITY, FRATERNITY, AND PATRIOTISM – Being a Knight of Christ is a good start.

As we look to the New Year, let us strive to give of the time we have so that we can be counted as one of God's good and faithful servants. We anticipate 2013 to be another busy year and we need all hands on deck. In the first two months we have Roses for Life, a Blood Drive, fish fries, Valentines Brunch, Coats for Kids, Essay and Free Throw contests, beneficial retreats, and planning for many other activities. We need ALL of our Brother Knights involvement. The coming year promises to be busy and extremely rewarding to those who get involved.
