Knights of Columbus Council 9981 Council Web Sites Strategy and IT Services

Whereas, the Council went on-line with its first web site in 2010 under the domain name of *IWknights.com*. That site is still live today and is hosted by its original developer, Zach Smyth, on his server as it has been since 2010. Zach has advised the Council that he would like to leave the web hosting business. The site operates on a WordPress platform and is designed to display best on desktop and laptop computers. This site as is requires some upgrades - perhaps significant - and the Council would need to hire a developer to plan and/or execute the upgrades. While we have no bid on the cost to move this site to a new hosting service, pay the annual domain charge and provide for maintenance plus upgrade the site - based on past experience **a good estimate might be \$300 annually and \$1,000+ for the programming upgrade**.

Whereas, since 2013 the Council has also maintained a mobile web site which displays on all platforms - i.e. smart phones, tablets, laptops and desktop computers. At this time the site can be accessed at: *http://kpages.mobi/k9981*. The site was built by a friend of the Council - Jim Bulan - at a cost of well above our budget but much of the work was provided pro-bono. It was first developed to use with our BBQ effort. Its strongest feature is the on-line/remote Ordering App. Over the last several years Jim has made several improvements to this Ordering App and hosted it on his server. For the future, he is offering to make further improvements to the site which will include merging the Square's remote payment process into the program. This represents a major part of our ecommerce solution for our Fish Fry business - which is key to our outside carry-out and on-line business strategy:

1) a customized mobile web site with a domain name changed to: www.StLFishFry.com;

2) a new hosting service;

3) an upgraded 3rd-party program featuring an integrated app which permits on-line/drivethru order taking with remote payment via our Square account.

The proposed annual cost is \$300. <u>NOTE</u>: Hosting and domain services and prices listed at *http//:Bulan.biz*.

Whereas, the Council recently learned of the existence of a Knights of Columbus web site which features a robust set of features built into a template and which includes web site hosting. Then at our planning meeting on June 23rd, we invited the state KofC web coordinator, Kevin Hudnut, to introduce and explain the order's UKnight web site program (*www.kofcknights.org* will link you to the UKnight Interactive site). We learned that more than 1,300 councils, assemblies and chapters use UKnight. Additionally we were advised that a council can: 1) purchase a template which permits us to build a web site, 2) obtain hosting of our web site and 3) permit us to our *IWknights.com* domain name. *The annual cost is \$150 per year.*

Finally Whereas, the Council needs two different types of web presence web sites. The <u>first web</u> <u>need is</u> for a multi-functional, interactive site which is promoted by the Knights under the UKnight name. As UKnight states in their advertising - it is "A solution for Knights of Columbus councils searching for a way to:

- ATTRACT new members
- ACTIVATE current members
- GENERATE INCOME for council activities
- INCREASE AWARENESS of Degree Events
- COMMUNICATE more efficiently
- ENHANCE community awareness"

The **second** web need is to provide us a dependable and user-friendly ecommerce site for our Fish Fry business. While the UKnight site is supposedly compatible with ecommerce, our solution is likely too complicated to fully integrate into that program although it is possible we can create a page with a link www.StLFishFry link.

Be it resolved, the sum of approximately \$500 be budgeted for the purchase website-related IT services as described above and itemized below (including the estimate for temporarily funding the hosting service for the original IWKnights.com until the UKnight template is converted to the new IWKnights.com web site). Approximately \$460 will become an annual expediture.

1) *www.IWKnights.com* - to move server and assume we may need to make payment - transfer and pay for the domain for a 3 to 5 year period.

a) Domain name registration of IWKnights.com (via transfer) - \$10.00 annually (hosting will be provided by UKnights);

b) temporary, one-time hosting services until the UKnight site is live - \$40.

2) <u>www.StLFishFry.com</u>

a) Domain name registration of StLFishFry.com, Business level hosting and Royalty payment for

use and maintenance of Ordering App = \$300/yr

 3) <u>Purchase the UKnights KofC web site template and once the necessary data is loaded</u> <u>into the system it will ultimately inherit the domain name of: www.IWKnights.com</u> a) Annual fee for template license including hosting - \$150/yr
