Resolution to Allocate Funds for the "That Man is You" Program

Be it resolved that Council 9981 plans to initiate and provide support to the "That Man is You Program" (TMIY) at Incarnate Word Parish in coordination with our Parish Clergy. TMIY is a weekly program with two sessions of thirteen weeks, each designed to develop men in the Catholic faith. TMIY is an ideal Segway from the Knights Faith in Action Program including our current Into the Breach study group. Data from others indicate that between 5-10% of the Parish men may become active participants.

Be it further resolved that Council 9981 hereby allocates \$1,500 to pay for the initial cost of books, banners and other small items needed to start the program. The participants will be charged \$10 per book to replenish the program funds which will be used to help fund the purchase of food for breakfasts on the mornings of the program. Breakfast is one of the three parts of the weekly program – breakfast; video; small group discussions. Council 9981 intends to raise or collect additional funds to cover breakfast expenses from one or more of the following resources: (i) funds from performing fundraisers (such as pancake breakfasts); (ii) funds provided by the parish; (iii) funds collected through good will offerings from participants.

To have supplies available to meet the scheduled start date of the TMIY Program, this resolution requests the temporary withdrawal of \$1,500 from Council 9981's General Fund. The amount of \$1,500 will be deposited back into the General Fund upon drafting of and approval by the members of the 2018-2019 Charitable Contributions Memo which will include this donation as a line item in the Church Activities budget allocations.
